- Worsening abdominal pain for 1 week.

Present Illness

- 4 months ago, the patient experienced abdominal pain with fever. The pain started in the periumbilical area and migrated to the right side.
- Was suspected to have appendicitis and was treated with antibiotics at a hospital in Austria.
- Following treatment, the symptoms gradually improved but never fully resolved.
- Over the past 4 months, has experienced intermittent, lingering abdominal pain.
- 1 week ago, the right-sided abdominal pain began to worsen.
- The pain is intermittent, with a severity of approximately 5/10, sometimes decreasing to 2/10.
- Associated with occasional nausea but no vomiting.
- Reports a subjective feeling of being warm but denies high fever.
- Also reports low appetite.
